Operating like a farmers market on wheels, our refrigerated trucks bring fresh, healthy food directly to underserved neighborhoods and food deserts throughout Northeast and North Central Florida.

Serving Vulnerable Communities

With 1 in 7 adults and 1 in 5 children facing food insecurity in our region, the Mobile Pantry program reaches communities where traditional pantries may not exist or are only open for limited days or hours. Our strategic mobile distributions help bridge the gap for the 310,000 food-insecure individuals across our service area.

How it Works

Our refrigerated trucks arrive loaded with nutritious food that volunteers arrange in a farmers market-style setup. Community members can "shop" for their selections with dignity and choice, but all food is provided free of charge. In some locations, we offer convenient drive-through distribution for those who cannot leave their vehicles.

Our Impact

- 2,080 mobile pantries delivered across our service area
- Each distribution serves approximately 200 households
- 7,700 pounds of fresh and packaged food at each distribution
- 70% of all distributed food is fresh including produce, dairy, and meat
