The Senior Hunger Program provides specially tailored meal boxes to homebound seniors and people with restricted mobility. Bi-weekly food distributions are held in low-income senior living communities to expand food access and support healthy lifestyles for seniors.

Why it Matters

1 in 15 seniors in Duval County are experiencing food insecurity, including many who struggle with limited mobility, fixed incomes, and health challenges. Beyond nourishment, the program builds connections. Susan, a volunteer, was making a food delivery to a neighbor who serves as a full-time caregiver for her husband living with Alzheimer's. "She asked to hug me and said it was a relief to be able to share her story with someone," Susan recalled. Each deliver does more than fill a box with food—it delivers dignity, connection, and reassurance.
